Silicon memory chip inside the i-button™.

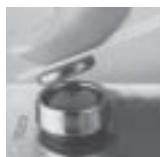
The HECON Quick-Key System is based on advanced semiconductor technology that allows instant and foolproof access to an unlimited number of users and an unlimited number of copiers, printers fax machines, etc.

The HECON Quick-Key 'button' (ibutton™) is a nonvolatile, silicon memory chip packaged in a rugged, stainless steel, miniature container with a sealed lid. This rugged and durable button preserves the chip even when subjected to corrosive conditions. These buttons are rated for over 150 million read/write cycles, *this can be up to 50,000 times greater than that of magnetic cards or chip cards.*

When touched, information is instantly transferred, verified and stored (after acceptable data integrity is confirmed). Buttons can be submersed in liquid, hit with up to ±10,000 volts of static electricity, exposed to severe temperatures or be subjected to the magnetic fields that would destroy the integrity of any magnetic card. The i-button™ benefits from a high-volume, low-cost packaging methodology known for its excellent ability to preserve contents.

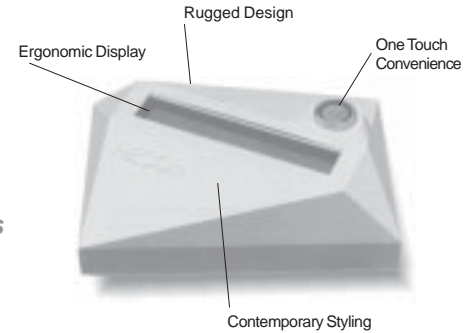
The Buttons interact with HECON Quick-Key Controllers by touching them to the Controller's receptacle. The receptacle is a single surface, bright, tarnish-resistant metal that provides for millions of operations. Simply by 'touching' the button to the Controller, you enable the copier or printer. The button contents change as copies or prints are made, and the ability to make copies or prints is disabled when the button is empty. Buttons can be reused almost indefinitely.

There are absolutely no moving parts in the Controller (Reader). They are impossible to "jam" and contain static components that will not break or wear out. HECON Quick-Key technology is light years ahead of popular competing technologies and has redefined copy and print management.

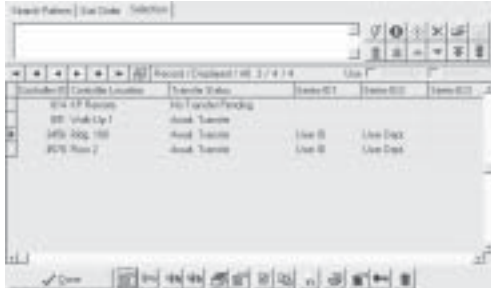

Access and User Data, such as ID, Name, Account Number, Address, Department, Phone Number, etc., is all managed through well thought out menu-driven navigational design.



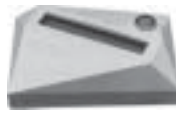
QK Software - User Status Window

Transferring information from the administrating PC to HECON QK buttons is accomplished via the PC Interface, which attaches to the PC's serial port.

Transferring and gathering information to and from the Controllers/Readers can be accomplished via a Probe, Link Cable or by creating a network. Our network software can accommodate both internal and external locations through the use of network nodes and modems. The software also has a built in auto-configuration feature making network setup for your IS department a breeze.

## Accessory Products

### Reset Controller



The Reset Controller enables an administrator to reset a button programmed in credit mode back to zero. This

is a stand-alone unit that simply plugs into any standard power outlet. The unit displays the number of copies made on Credit Buttons. Once a button is touched and the value is displayed, the value on the credit button is automatically reset to zero. The display on the controller will show the last amount until a programmable timeout is reached or a different button is touched. This product is frequently used in applications to display usage for walk-in, self-serve copier customers.

### Vending and Revalue Stations

Other accessory items for this system include the Vending and Revalue Stations. These products provide simple and reliable *unattended* vending. It allows users



to purchase and revalue their buttons by using cash at self-access locations. The Revalue Station can be used independently to revalue a user's button or together with the Vending Station. The Vending Station can dispense a button to a user with values that the system administrators can preprogram themselves.

### Cash Station

The Cash Station enables a user to debit a dollar amount from a user's button. This stand alone unit is most often used in conjunction with a cash register. The Cash Station charges already existing debit value buttons with any amount entered in through the integrated keypad. An LCD display shows the amount being debited and also prompts the user through the setup process.



The Cash Station also keeps a total of the value charged from all buttons used at the station. The integrated resettable totalizer can be used to reconcile totals from the cash register. There is a port to connect our portable printer for hard copy reports on totals and the balance of up to 1,700 buttons used at the station. There is also a function to allow a supervisor to correct transactions and credit amounts back to a button.

### Quick-Key™ Buttons



There are two versions of the HECON Quick-Key button available. *Model 1* buttons are designed for credit use only and store information directly

in a Series II and III Controller, whereas *Model 2* (credit/debit format) buttons store information in the button's memory itself and work with all Controllers.

### Mounting Devices

The Card Mount, Key Chain Mount (Fob) and Ultra High Strength, Self-



Stick Tape Pads (tape pads not pictured here) are three different ways High Tech

provides for mounting buttons. A button can also be mounted on an existing key ring, ID card, badge, or any other flat surface.



### Button Security Tag



Our Security Tag provides for secure mounting of buttons in situations where they are being used in public environments.

For example, walk-up copier applications in print shops, libraries and government public record areas.

### Mounting Brackets

There are two mounting bracket styles available to secure Controllers to or near the copier. Top/Front or Rear brackets make the Controller an



integral part of the copier while providing optimal placement for daily use. Mounting brackets are made of heavy gauge steel to provide you with the most secure mounting possible.

All necessary hardware is included along with instructions on how to mount the brackets to the machine.

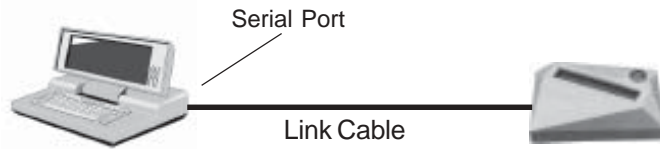

# DATA COMMUNICATION - 4 WAYS TO CONNECT (For Series II and III)

There are four options available for communication with the HECON Quick-Key™ System. They include: direct connection, modem direct, local node network (LAN) and modem/node network.

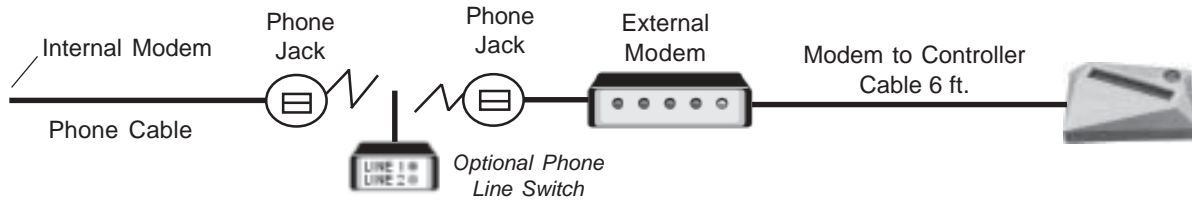
## Option 1 - Direct Connection

Enables information to be transferred to and from each controller via a Link Cable connected to a laptop.



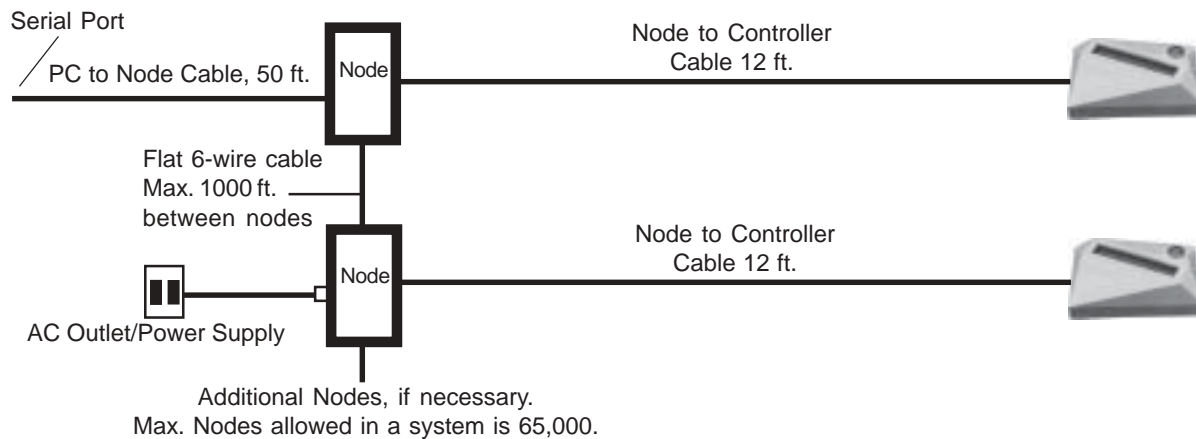
## Option 2 - Modem Direct

Links controllers to a computer using analog phone lines, from building to building or across the country.



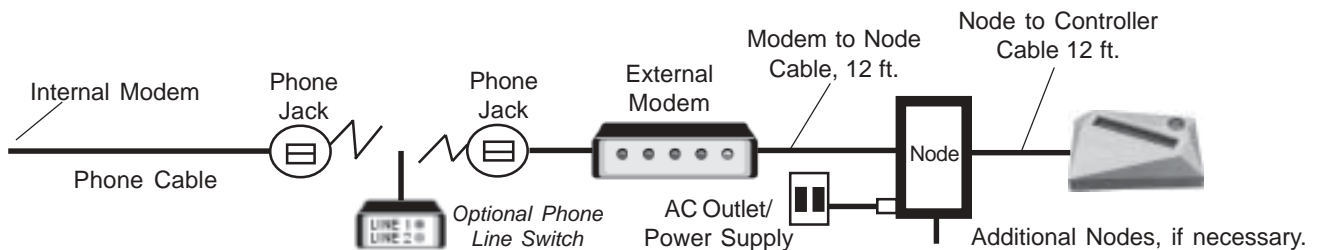
## Option 3 - Local Node Network (LAN)

Links controllers to a computer by using nodes which are connected by dedicated, 6-wire phone cable. Nodes can be up to 1000 feet apart.



## Option 4 - Modem/Node Network

Links controllers to computer by utilizing both modems and nodes from building to building or across the country.



## Minimum System Requirements

- Pentium processor, 100 MHz minimum, running Windows® 95 or higher OS.
